

RULES and REGULATIONS

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF, CHSA, CHJA or NEHC rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

To show in CHSA, CHJA or NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHSA, CHJA or NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC. A copy of the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership application are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net

1. Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
 2. Hunter championships will be awarded in accordance with USEF rules. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points performing over a hunter course. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. 1st - 6th awarded in all classes. Championship and Reserve will be awarded in all divisions.
 3. The committee reserves the right to change or vary the courses at their discretion.
 4. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
 5. Scratches will be accepted only with the veterinarian's or medical certificate at least one hour before classes begin. No other scratches will be allowed except at the discretion of management.
 6. All entries must be signed by the Owner, Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to numbers being released. Entries close 48 hours prior to show. Post entries will be accepted at an additional \$15.00 per horse.
 7. A processing fee of \$25.00 shall be charged for each non negotiable check. Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid entry fees will be billed for these charges and a \$35.00 billing fee will be added to the total due.
 8. All dogs must be leashed at ALL times.
 9. Every animal entered for competition shall be under control of the committee, but Shallowbrook Equestrian Center will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor shall hold Shallowbrook Equestrian Center as well as the Show Committee harmless for any loss or accident which may occur. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.
11. The horse show committee reserves the right to decline any entry.

The Show will be held on either one or both of the rings listed below, weather permitting

The show ring (**outdoor**) is the grass annex ring and also a section of the Polo field. The show ring (**indoor**) is 110' by 225' with a dirt and dead sand footing.

The warm-up ring (indoor) and standing area is 50' by 200' with same footing as show ring

Take 84E. to 91N. to Exit 47E then follow directions from Hartford/Springfield.

From Boston:

Take Mass Pike to I-84 West, take Exit 72 (Stafford Springs Rt. 190). Go Right onto Rt. 190 W. Follow thru Stafford into Somers Center (Somers inn) 2 Miles after center take Left onto Rt. 186 (also called Hall Hill Road). Shallowbrook is 1 Mile on Left.
