

Rules and Regulations

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF, CHSA, CHJA or NEHC rule books will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

To show in CHJA or NEHC Medal classes, riders MUST be members. In order to compete for CHSA, CHJA or NEHC annual year-end awards, the owner of the horse or pony must be a member of the CHJA and the horse or pony must be registered with the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC. A copy of the CHSA, CHJA or NEHC Rule Book, class specifications, Medal class specifications, and membership application are available at the show secretary's office and at www.chja.net and www.chsaonline.com.

- Hunter classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Equitation classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse.
- Hunter championships will be awarded in accordance with USEF rules. Championship and Reserve ribbons will be awarded to two of the four horses which have acquired the most points performing over a hunter course. In addition to these points, only these four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in under saddle classes. 1st - 6th awarded in all classes.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide classes if warranted.
- Office fee is \$20.00. Warmup fee \$15.00. All entries must be signed by the Owner, Trainer and Rider (or Parent/Guardian) prior to numbers being released. Entries close 24 hours prior to show. Post entries will be accepted at an additional \$15.00 per horse.
- A processing fee of \$25.00 shall be charged for each non negotiable check. Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid entry fees will be billed for these charges and a \$35.00 billing fee will be added to the total due.
- All dogs must be leashed at all times.
- Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of the show management, but Shallowbrook Equestrian Center will in no way be responsible for any damage that may occur by fire or otherwise, and it shall be a condition of every entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer and attendants hold the competition & Shallowbrook Equestrian Center, and its members, employees and agents harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals or property at the show. Should any question or dispute arise, it shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.
- The horse show reserves the right to decline any entry.

From Hartford, I-91 North, and Springfield, MA, I-91 South:

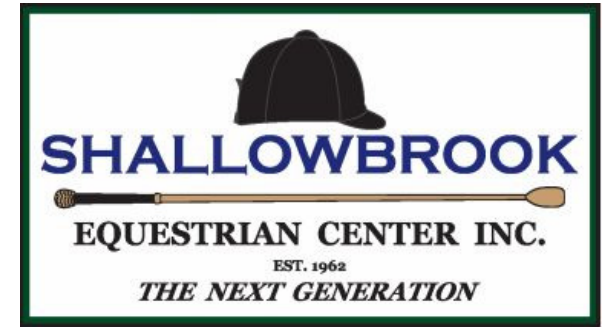
Take Exit 47E onto Rt. 190 East. Go 5.5 miles. Take a Left onto Rt. 186 (Hall Hill Road). There is a light at this intersection. Shallowbrook is 1 mile on the left.

From Danbury:

Take I-84 East to I-91 North, then Exit 47E. Follow directions from Hartford/Springfield (above).

From Boston:

Take the Mass Pike (I-90) to I-84 West. Take Exit 73 (Stafford Springs, Rt. 190). At the end of the exit ramp, take a Right to go West on Rt. 190. Follow through Stafford and then to Somers Center (you'll see the Somers Inn on your Right). Continue 2 miles past Somers Center and take a Left onto Rt. 186 (Hall Hill Road). Shallowbrook is 1 mile on the left.
